IndyFeral offers Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) assistance whereby *un-owned, free-roaming, stray and feral (wild) cats* are humanely trapped, examined, vaccinated and sterilized by a veterinarian. We encourage people to make efforts to use the resources of adoption organizations to attempt to place tame cats and kittens into homes. Cats too wild to be adopted are returned to their familiar habitat and monitored by their caretakers.
